Who is IDADA?

IDADA, the Indianapolis Downtown Artists and Dealers Association, is a non-profit membership based organization of studio artists, art galleries and arts-related businesses within the 20 block square of the center of Indianapolis.

What does IDADA do?

The prime focus is the creation and marketing of unique and original art. IDADA's mission is to

IDADA Memberships

Individual artists, studio artists, art galleries and arts-related businesses that meet the geography requirement will have full voting privileges, benefits and all other member services.

Studio Artist - An individual visual artist who has a studio in the Harrison, Murphy, Stutz, Wheeler, or any future art building that operates within the IDADA area. Artist members must at some time during the year have their studio open to the public.

Art Gallery - A business selling fine art, having specific gallery hours open to the public.

Arts-Related Business - A business that supplies or supports the visual arts.

Associate Member (non-voting member) - An individual or business that wishes to support the mission of IDADA but is from outside the geographic area or a non-arts unrelated industry, but has the opportunity to participate in IDADA's promotional activities.

Friend of IDADA (non-voting member) - A supporter and friend of the visual arts in Indianapolis.
